**CHARITY/PHILANTHROPIC ACTIVITIES:**✓ **SPG FOUNDATION:**

In 2007, Princess Stella Oduah Founded the SPG Charitable Life Foundation to further consolidate her humanitarian and philanthropic Efforts, the foundation mission is to develop and implement



strategic programs / projects that would empower and build the capacity of the under privileged members of the society with emphasis on the woman and child.

The foundation is anchored on the divine ethos that every man is a mere custodian of what he possesses. She believes that Wealth acquisition is a God Given grace and not necessarily an act of human ingenuity, and that wealth acquisition makes sense only if it is spread to affect the lives of the less privileged around you.

The foundation's program cuts across the following themes

- Childs right and child's development.
- Gender health and development
- Youth empowerment and capacity building
- Poverty eradication and wealth creation and
- Rural development.

✓ **JOE LIFE FOUNDATION:**

Joe Life Education Foundation was founded in 2007 by Princess Stella Oduah to champion the cause of the less privileged child in Nigeria.

The foundation was established to promote development of the less privileged and vulnerable children in Nigeria, through the provision of a conducive social and economic environment for capacity development of the child

The Foundations objectives include:

1. Improving access to quality education for less privileged and vulnerable children
2. Contribute to the development and upgrading of public educational institutions and infrastructure.
3. Enhance total child development through child fostering program
4. Contribute toward the eradication of child trafficking and abuse.
5. Provide a platform for private sector involvement in the Nigeria child educational development.

The Foundation's Programs run presently in Seven (7) states of the federation namely Benue, Anambra, Katsina, Edo, Baylesa, Delta, and Lagos States.

✓ **SKILLS ACQUISITION PROGRAMME:**

Princess Stella Oduah established a Skill acquisition centre in Ogbaru Local Government Area in Anambra state in 2007 and in Orhionwon LGA in Edo state in 2009 to help in the capacity development and economic empowerment of indigent youths.

The establishment of these centers is the first phase of her Nigeria youth empowerment programme which is aimed at reducing poverty, youth restiveness, unemployment and prevalence of cyber and related crimes.



These centers since their establishment have graduated no fewer than a hundred youths in fields such as, Computer Appreciation, Fashion and Designing, Electrical Electronics, Welding and Fabrication, Catering, Hair Dressing and Auto mechanics.

✓ **EKHO HEART FOUNDATION/ MODUPE CANCER INITIATIVE:**

In 2009, Princess Stella Oduah, launched an elaborate gender health advocacy programme under the aegis of the Ekho heart foundation.

It was established to create awareness and attend to cardiovascular health issues among indigent women. While the Modupe cancer initiative was established to advocate for the prevention and control of HPV and cervical cancer through:

1. Awareness creation and sensitization.
2. Provision of vaccines to indigent women.
3. Advocacy for Government interventions in the provision of vaccines and test for women.

✓ **FARMERS MICROFINANCE SCHEME:**

As part of her fervent commitment to fight and end poverty and the empowerment of indigent members of the society, Princess Stella Oduah launched the Farmers Loan scheme for peasant and subsistent farmers in Ogbaru LGA of Anambra State in 2006.

The Scheme which has run for successive years within the Ogbaru LGA has over 150 recipients (still counting) and is received every year with the supervision of the community leaders and the Ogbaru Community bank.

✓ **WOMEN CASSAVA FARMERS INITIATIVE:**

In 2009, Princess Stella Oduah floated the women cassava initiative in Ugbeghili in Orhionwon LGA of Edo state. The Scheme which is at its first phase provides a soft loan of N100,000 to more than 30 indigent peasant women cassava farmers within the community and is aimed at providing also for men in the subsequent phases of the program.

Through this scheme she also hopes to establish cassava-processing plant within the community to purchase and utilize the produce from these various farms.

✓ **POTABLE WATER SCHEME**

In 2003 Princess Stella Oduah through her water for life initiative sponsored the drilling of boreholes and the installation of Howden Rotary Hand Pumps and submersible pumps in some rural communities in Anambra and Adamawa State. In a bid to improve access to portable water and contribute to the prevention of water born diseases.

Princess Stella Oduah Through the SPG Charitable Life Foundation have carried out other numerous community development and Philanthropic projects such as the construction of class room structures in 2007 and payment of tuition fees for students of Akilli Ozizor community secondary School From 2007 till date.

She also constructed classroom blocks for the primary schools in Akilli Ozizor in Anambra State and Ugbeghili in Edo State in 2007 and 2009 respectively.

Princess has also constructed a community worship center at Akilli- Ozizor in 2007 and Ugbeghili in 2009, and has actively supported different orphanages across the country amongst, which are the arrow of God Orphanage In Badore Lagos State and Our Ladies Orphanage in Onitsha Anambra state.
