This Zone, according to critical findings out of 87 Wards and 1,792 P.U's, the PDP has a total number of 33 Wards, 641 Polling Units respectively.

THE TASK BEFORE PDP AND GOVERNOR YERO

2nd April, 2015

Introduction

It is necessary to understand the voting behaviour of the electorate, based on the outcome of the first round of the elections.

It may be recalled that in our previous submission on this subject, we accurately forecasted the results of the Presidential and National Assembly elections. Almost all of our projections have become true.

Therefore, the need to implement this very submission becomes imperative, because all the findings contained herein are like the gospel truth. Failure to implement the contents of this piece religiously, will definitely spell doom for both the PDP and Governor Yero.

2. The Voting pattern in the three (3) Zones of Kaduna State on April 11, 2015.

It is necessary also to appreciate the fact that voting among the three (3) Zones cannot be uniform. Under this sub-head, we will give the highlights of the Zones according to the realities of today. The highlights will also involve tabular presentation of some facts and figures for clarity.

- a) **Zone I:** In this zone, there are (8) Eight Local Government Areas which are distinct and dynamic in their own right. It has (87) eighty seven Wards and (1,792) One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Two Polling Units. In reference to the previous submission, on Presidential and National Assemblies elections, we have stated that this Zone was a Zone that is a sure banker and is controlled by the opposition.

Subsequently, the table below has captured only the LGA's, Wards and Polling Units that are possible swingers and comfort Zones for the PDP.

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b) **Zone II:** Exclusively, this Zone has (7) Seven Local Government Areas, (81) Eighty One Wards and (1,977) One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy Seven Polling Units. In our previous submission, we have equally stipulated that this Zone is also a strong hold of the APC. Subsequent upon this, the table below has captured only Local Government, Wards and Polling Units that the PDP has relative advantage.

Remarks on the analysis of Zone II

This Zone, after critical studies has 81 Wards, 1,977 Polling Units out of which PDP has 32 Wards and 701 Polling Units concomitantly.

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- c) **Zone III:** As it were, this Zone has (8) Eight Local Government Areas, (87) Eighty Seven Wards and (1,333) One Thousand Three Hundred and Thirty Three Polling Units. Based on our earlier submission, this zone is a PDP strong hold and a comfort zone. Therefore, the table below tends to highlight only the areas where the APC has relative advantage

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The remarks on the analysis of Zone III

In this Zone, out of 87 Wards, 1,333 Poling Units, the APC has 28 Wards and 307 Polling Units.

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Means, Measures and Ways to be adopted by PDP and Governor Yero

After careful studies and analysis of the above critical submission, it should be understood that to actually give it a credence, full implementation and holistic adoption of the following means and methodology must be observed.

The methodologies below are in Steps according to imperatives.

Step I: Based on the lessons learnt, whatever strategy of winning election that will be deployed in Polling Units and the collation centres, the handlers must avoid being detected or exposed which will possibly initiate a Judicial proceedings or inimical response by either agents of retrogression or Elections Observer missions.

Step II: In areas we mentioned that APC has advantage in Southern – Kaduna, ref. table (C), election materials distribution should be delayed, the means of dividing of the minds of the electorate should be initiated, the ad-hoc staff should be reached out and compromised.

Step III: In Areas where the PDP has advantage ref. table (a) & (b), efforts should be made for speedy accreditation of large number of voters, manipulation of figures should be exercised in a profound way and where possible, ballot boxes stuffing must be effectively ensured.

Step IV: During collation, areas such as Zaria LGA, Igabi LGA, Kaduna – North LGA and Sabon – Gari LGA with Soba LGA should be collated and announced on time to allow for the assessment of their performance in relation to areas we have advantages. It is also expedient to frustrate voters, if possible reduce their numerical advantage by either disenfranchising them or deploy other methods that are inimical to their strength.

Step V: Effort should be made to set up a committee to immiadtely identify, locate and discourage the members of PDP that are either aggrieved or not satisfied with the PDP and are ready to votes against the PDP or conduct anti – party activities during the election.

Step VI: Concerted efforts should be made to employ the services of ad-hoc staffs to sabotage or compromised the performance of the *Card – Reader*.

4) **Feed back**

In all of these, time is of the essence and three days before elections, all the feedback that are related to these steps, means, methodology should be analyzed and appreciated for effective deployment.

5) **Conclusions**

It was discovered that in Southern – Kaduna there will be tremendous voters apathy which will drastically reduce the numerical advantage of the PDP. Efforts should be made to immediately correct this anomaly.

By popular observation, it is understandable that crisis and flash – points will be experienced during the gubernatorial elections which will truncate the entire process.

Furthermore, we have started preparing for an update or a follow up to this submission immediately we finish our compilations.
